

Article 9 - Dues Deduction

Q: How are association dues deducted from my paycheck?

A: By signing the Association membership form you authorize the district to deduct dues from your paycheck each month in 12 equal installments.

Q: Do I need to sign a membership form every year to maintain my association membership?

A: Association membership is continuous from year to year. You do not need to sign a membership form every year.

Q: I've decided to revoke my Association membership. What do I need to do?

A: First we hope you have really considered what it means to give up your Association membership. Given that, you will need to complete the membership revocation form, which you can request from AEA. Once that form has been completed and turned into the Association we will communicate your decision to revoke your membership to payroll. The revocation window is July 1-August 10.

Q: I am leaving district employment before the end of my contract. Will the remainder of my dues be deducted from my last paycheck?

A: In order not to have the remainder of the annual dues deducted from your last paycheck, you will need to notify the Association that you are resigning by completing a membership revocation form before the 10th of the month in which you receive your last paycheck.
